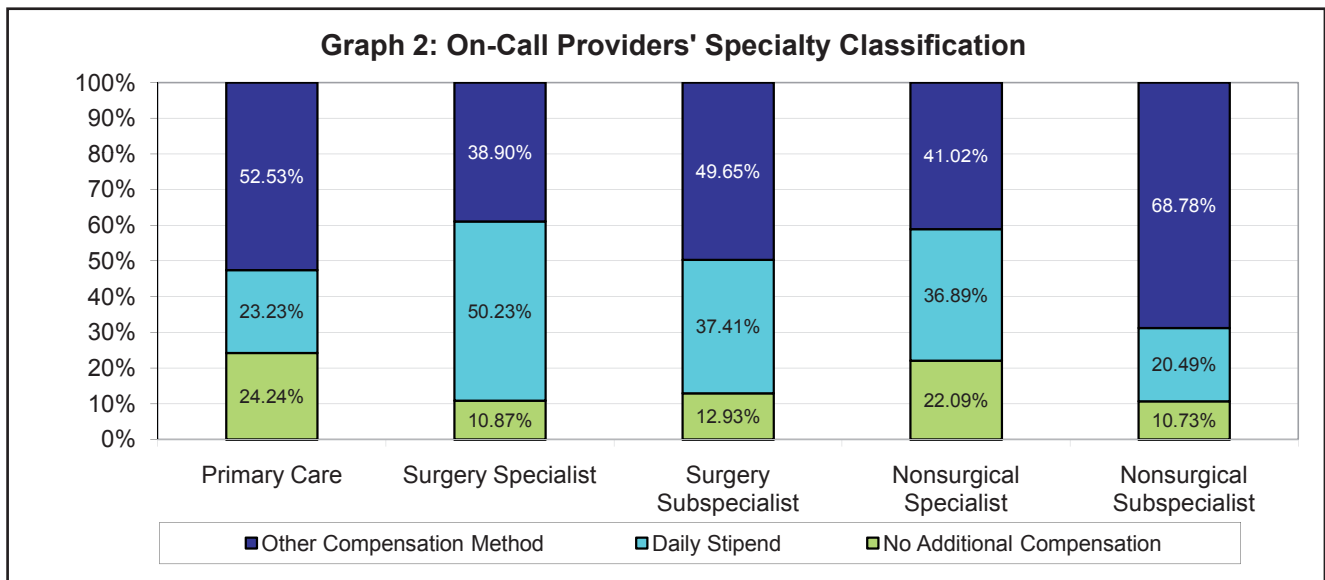


Thirty-eight percent of all providers surveyed do not receive additional compensation for their on-call coverage. The most commonly used compensation method for on-call coverage among reporting providers was daily stipend (29 percent).



More than half of **Primary Care** and **Nonsurgical** providers (52.53 percent and 68.78 percent, respectively) reported receiving some form of additional compensation. More than half of **Surgical Specialist** providers earned a daily stipend for their additional on-call coverage.
